## **Decoding God's Work: Best TV Documentary** **Trento Film Festival Awards SALT + LIGHT Production**

**TORONTO, October 16, 2006** – The Salt + Light Television production **Opus Dei: Decoding God's Work** has been awarded the **Best TV Documentary** at the *Religion Today Film Festival* in Trento, Italy.

Over 120 films were submitted for consideration to the festival, with only 45 accepted for screening. **Opus Dei: Decoding God's Work** was among those selected and screened on Thursday October 12<sup>th</sup>. The awards ceremony was held on Saturday October 14<sup>th</sup> where 13 of the films and producers were individually recognized for their work.

David Naglieri, one of the two co-producers of the film was in Trento for the festival: *"I am thrilled to see Salt + Light recognized for the quality work it has been doing for the Catholic Church in Canada and around the world. This film was made as a response to the many distortions and misunderstandings spread by The Da Vinci Code phenomenon; I am glad we were able to tell the world about the real Opus Dei."*

Marc Boudignon, another Salt and Light Producer who worked on the film was equally delighted to hear about the recognition: *"I'm ecstatic to have won this award. I couldn't have hoped for such a great reception at Trento. Through St. Josemaria, our film is but another envelope carrying the message of Jesus Christ to more and more people everyday."*

**Opus Dei: Decoding God's Work** unveils the history and significance of St. Josemaría Escrivá and "The Work" God entrusted to him. Featuring interviews with Opus Dei leaders throughout the world and Vatican Affairs expert John Allen, this riveting documentary examines Dan Brown's many myths and distortions in the Da Vinci Code and presents another portrait of Opus Dei.
